



## November 2010 - Update

### Stony Plain Care Centre Continuing Care facility

The new Stony Plain Care Centre will be a state-of-the-art facility containing many features that residents, families, visitors, staff and volunteers will quickly come to appreciate. Below is a snap shot of just a few features:

- The building will comprise of over 95,000 square feet and will contain 126 rooms for residents, generous amenity and program and office space.
- All of the rooms will be private and will have their own self-contained washroom equipped with an accessible shower. Generous room sizes will allow residents to enjoy visits from family and friends.
- The new building will be attached to the existing Alzheimer/dementia cottage which has 30 residents for a total of 156 residents.

#### Update on Construction

The new Care Center is approximately 50% completed which is on schedule. The following is a breakdown of some of the activities currently taking place.

- Window installation and exterior drywall application is currently underway.
- All steel framework is completed and wood framing is advancing.
- Concrete slabs in the basement are complete and electrical and plumbing “rough ins” is progressing.
- With winter fast approaching, 3 wings of the building will be completed to a level that they will be able to be heated by the end of November, therefore causing no slow down in construction. The 4<sup>th</sup> wing will be ready to be heated by January.

Building completion remains on schedule for late summer 2011.



#### What is the cost for the new building?

The total cost for The Good Samaritan Stony Plain Care Centre Phase II is nearly \$31,000,000. The Good Samaritan Society received a capital grant from the Government of Alberta for \$14,700,000 and The Society is running a capital campaign called “CLOSE TO HOME” that has a fundraising goal of \$3,000,000. The outstanding balance owing will then be mortgaged.
